

Councilmember Jerry D. Pate introduced the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 760-08

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MONTHLY SALARY OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS
THIS ORDINANCE SUPERCEDES ORDINANCE # 477-95 ADOPTED DECEMBER 14, 1995

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HELENA, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the salary of the Mayor of the City of Helena, Alabama, shall be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of \$1,250.00 plus a \$500.00 expense per month, \$21,000.00 annually.

Section 2. That each Councilmember of the City of Helena, Alabama shall be compensated at the sum of \$150.00 per meeting, not to exceed \$300.00 per month, \$3,600.00 annually.

Section 3. In addition to the salary provided for herein, the Mayor and Councilmembers shall be entitled to additional compensation for completion of Certified Municipal Official training established by the Alabama League of Municipalities:

a. Upon completion of the prescribed courses by the Alabama League of Municipalities resulting in the awarding of the designation of "Certified Municipal Official", the Mayor and any Councilmember shall receive an additional \$15.00 per month or \$180.00 annually to be paid in the same manner as any other compensation.

b. Upon presentation of proof of the awarding of the designation of "Certified Municipal Official", either basic or advanced, the Mayor or Councilmember's salary shall be increased as provided herein beginning the next pay period after being awarded the designation.

Section 4. In addition to the salary provided herein, the Mayor and Councilmembers shall also be entitled to any cost of living raises granted to all full-time employees of the city.

Section 5. There will be no compensation for the Mayor and Councilmembers for attending special called meetings.

Section 6. This ordinance shall become effective on the first Monday in November, 2008 and shall continue in force and effect until repealed by action of the Council.

Section 7. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable; if any portion of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.
